British Columbia Miniature Horse Club
2008 – Yearling & 2 Year Old Canadian Futurity
(Horses born in 2006 & 2007)

ELIGIBILITY:

The owner of the foal, registered with the AMHA and also residing in Region 10 may participate in the BCMHC Canadian Futurity by complying with these rules. Nominated foal must have been born in the year of 2006 or 2007. The owner of the nominated foals must live in area 10 in Canada *and be current BCMHC members.*

OFFICIAL SHOW:

The B.C. Spring Classic show held in Cloverdale, B.C., will be the official show for the B.C.M.H.C. Futurity. All entries must be post marked before the end of Dec. 31st of 2007. Additional costs must be enclosed with the nomination form if mailed after Dec. 31st and received by April 30th/08 of the following year. It is strongly recommended to mail your entries in early to avoid any postal problems.

FEE SCHEDULE:

2006 Foals: (2 years old in 2008)

By Dec. 31, 2007\$35.00
 Between Dec. 31/07 to April 30/08...(Late fee)..... 50.00
 If not entered as a yearling in 2007 fee (\$25.00 + 35.00) =.....60.00
 (\$25.00 fee is the late yearling fee to enter in the 2 year olds) if entered after April 2008
 the fee is then.....\$75.00

2007 Foals:(1 year old in 2008)

By Dec. 31, 2007\$25.00
 Between Dec. 31/07 to April 30/08 ...(Late fee)..... 40.00

There will be the regular entry fee for the class in the show i.e \$25. – see Spring Classic Program.

RULES:

To be eligible for the Futurity honours and prize money, entrants must be current in their futurity nominations, and be the registered owners of the AMHA Horse. **All horses must be shown in a regular halter class at the show. It can be Amateur, Open or Youth which ever is appropriate for the handler and horse.**

Horses to be shown in their appropriate sex class, male or female and by age.

In the event that the foal is sold before the Futurity class, Futurity eligibility is transferred to the new owner. The seller should provide the nomination certificate and Futurity information to the new owner by the seller. The new owner must pay the fees when they come due to keep the horse eligible. They should also provide a new copy of the AMHA papers noting the ownership transfer. At time of showing the horses are to be shown under the current AMHA rules. Note all horses must reside in Canada, no exceptions.

CLOSING DATE:

As soon as any fees in the schedule become past due, that horse is no longer eligible for the futurity and the owner forfeits any fees paid up to that time.

No late or post entries will be accepted under any circumstances.

No refunds or substitutions for any reason. .
